This leaflet is a summary of the Community Strategy – a document produced by the Local Strategic Partnership (LSP) which sets out what we are planning to do over the next 5 years to improve public services in the borough.

**Why do we need a Community Strategy?**

The government requires the Partnership to produce a Community Strategy in consultation with local people. It should set out our priorities for improvement and goals that we need to achieve in order to make this happen. The Partnership will work together to achieve this.

This strategy is also part of a longer term document – ‘Vision 2026’, which looks at what we can do to improve the borough over the next 20 years.

**Our aim is to transform Telford & Wrekin into “a successful, prosperous and healthy community which offers a good quality of life for all the people of Telford & Wrekin”.**

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**What are the priorities for improvement?**

The Community Strategy has six priorities for the Partnership to work on over the next 5 years. *These are:*



**1. Transforming Telford & Wrekin** – putting in place services and facilities (for example, roads, transport and buildings) to ensure that Telford & Wrekin continues to thrive and develop.



**2. Children & Young People** – the Community Strategy has 5 aims for children and young people in the borough:

- To be healthy
- To be safe
- To enjoy and achieve
- To make a positive contribution in their communities
- To be economically secure



**3. A Sustainable and Quality Environment** – improving access and public transport, developing a clean and safe environment, reducing waste and increasing recycling.

**4. Safe, Strong and Cohesive Community** – reducing crime and building stronger communities.

**5. Healthier Communities and Vulnerable People** – promoting healthy lifestyles and supporting people to live independently.

**6. Local Economy and Skills** – encouraging and supporting business in the area and improving the skills of the local workforce.
